Fairfield celebrates opening of major connector road

Fairfield, California (Wednesday, August 2, 2017)—With much anticipation, the ribbon will be cut on August 8 on the final extension of Manuel Campos Parkway that will link the northeast part of town directly to I-80.

As a major component of the Villages at Fairfield, a Lewis Planned Community, the half-mile road extension near Mystic Drive will improve traffic safety for Paradise Crest residents and circulation for cyclists and pedestrians. Site work for the initial neighborhoods has started, and home construction will commence later this summer.

When completed, this tree-lined, planned community will consist of 1,800 homes, retail, schools, two community parks, five miles of trails, and is within one mile of the Fairfield-Vacaville Train Station, which is due to open this fall.

Join the Fairfield City Council and Lewis Management executives in the community celebration to open this important cross-town road in Fairfield on Tuesday, August 8 at 6 p.m. The location is on Manuel Campos Parkway near Mystic Drive.
