Proposals sought for housing projects serving special needs populations

Fairfield, California (Thursday, August 10, 2017) - The City of Fairfield (Authority) is seeking applications for financing from qualified developers for projects that will provide housing within the city of Fairfield to individuals that are elderly, near elderly, disabled, or receiving supportive services.

The source of funds for this RFP is the federal Housing Trust Fund. The competitive scores of respondents to this RFP will also be used to award up to twenty Project Based Vouchers (PBVs) to eligible projects. It is the intent of the Authority to award PBVs to the highest scoring projects based on the scoring criteria in the RFP.

All proposals will be evaluated on scoring criteria developed by the Authority. The scoring criteria and other information regarding the application process is available from the Authority's website at www.fairfield.ca.gov/gov/depts/cd/authority.asp.

About the Fairfield Housing Authority

The City of Fairfield Housing Authority (FHA) administers the Housing Choice Vouchers program funded by the US Department of Housing and Urban Development to provide tenant based rental assistance. The FHA is responsible for managing 882 vouchers, enabling families to secure decent, safe, and quality housing throughout the city of Fairfield.

Eligible applicants receiving a voucher are responsible for locating a unit in the private rental market. All rental units must meet the Housing Quality Standards, and are inspected prior to approval for the program.
