Fairfield Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project underway

Fairfield, California (Tuesday, September 12, 2017) - California Trenchless is performing the City's Sanitary Sewer 2017 Rehabilitation Project, which began on September 11 and will extend through December 2017.

The project includes replacing the sewer pipeline along the following streets: Adams, Jefferson, Oregon, Union, Nevada, and Kennedy Court.

The sanitary sewer system in this area was constructed in the 1950s and 1960s and has reached the end of its service life. The purpose of the project is to replace the sewer mains, sewer laterals and sewer cleanouts to provide more reliable sanitary sewer service to the residents.

Please expect an impact to traffic flow due to lane and road closures. A reduced speed limit will be enforced. Access to residences and businesses will be maintained at all times. Noise levels may be increased at times. Workdays will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

We appreciate your cooperation and we will try to minimize the inconvenience as much as possible for the duration of the project.
