Hillview Park affected during PSA improvement project

Fairfield, California (Thursday, January 25, 2018)— A small portion of Hillview Neighborhood Park will be used as a staging area for Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District Public Safety Academy Improvement Project.

The Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District is undertaking a \$15 million improvement project at its Public Safety Academy (PSA) on Atlantic Ave, adjacent to Hillview Neighborhood Park. The district will use a small, east portion of the park as a staging area for the project, according to Fairfield Manager of Park Planning, Fred Beiner.

“The City of Fairfield and Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District have a long-standing joint facilities use agreement, which allows the two entities to work together to help bring a new library and gymnasium to the PSA campus,” says Beiner.

With the passing of measure J, the Fairfield-Suisun School District continues to make improvements at various campuses. The PSA is approved to receive a new campus library and gym. The location of the improvements makes them difficult to construct with the limited amount of space along the Atlantic Ave. frontage. The City has agreed to let the district use a small, underutilized segment of Hillview Neighborhood Park to stage their construction activities.

At the conclusion of the construction project, the district will completely refurbish the segment of the park used for their construction activities. The district is expected to need the space until the end of June.
