City of Fairfield celebrates Public Service Week

Fairfield, California (Monday, May 7, 2018)— During the Fairfield City Council meeting on May 1, Mayor Harry T. Price decreed May 6-12, 2018 officially as “Public Service Recognition Week” as he presented a proclamation to Human Resources Director Allison Picard. He stated, “I encourage all citizens to recognize the accomplishments and contributions of government employees at all levels, and, in particular, at the City of Fairfield.”
