Obtain candidate election nomination kit from City Clerk

Fairfield, California (Thursday, June 28, 2018) – One mayoral seat and two council seats will be open for election on November 6, 2018. Persons interested in running for any of these seats may obtain candidate nomination papers from the City Clerk's Office beginning Monday, July 16, 2018. The deadline for filing nomination paperwork is 5 p.m., Friday, August 10, 2018, unless an incumbent does not file by that time, in which case the filing period for that seat will be extended to 5 p.m. Wednesday, August 15, 2018.

Potential candidates may obtain a Candidate's Kit beginning July 16, 2018 by making an appointment with the City Clerk's Office. Kits are available by appointment only by contacting Karen L. Rees, city clerk at (707) 428-7767 or by email at klrees@fairfield.ca.gov. The City Clerk's Office is located at 1000 Webster Street, Fairfield, 4th floor. Office hours are 8 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. However, the office is closed on Fridays, July 20 and August 3.

In addition, potential candidates are required to comply with regulations of the California Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC), which requires the filing of a State of California Form 501, "Candidate Intention Statement," prior to the solicitation or receipt of any contributions, or expenditure of any personal funds, related to the upcoming election.
